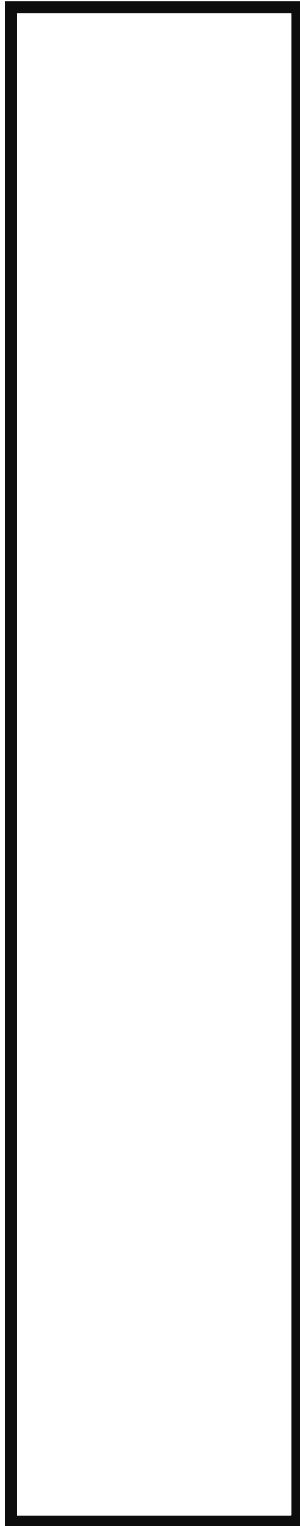
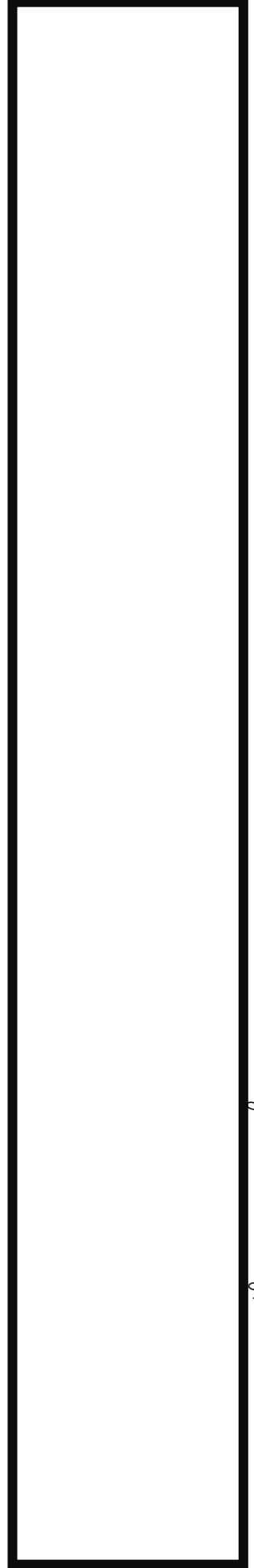
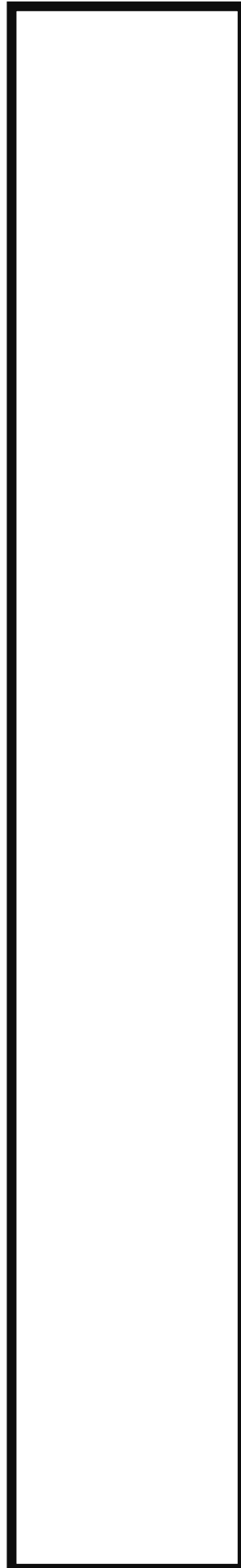


# HEADBAND

Print on white paper and decorate. Cut pieces apart, glue the dinosaur to headband, and staple band together to wear.



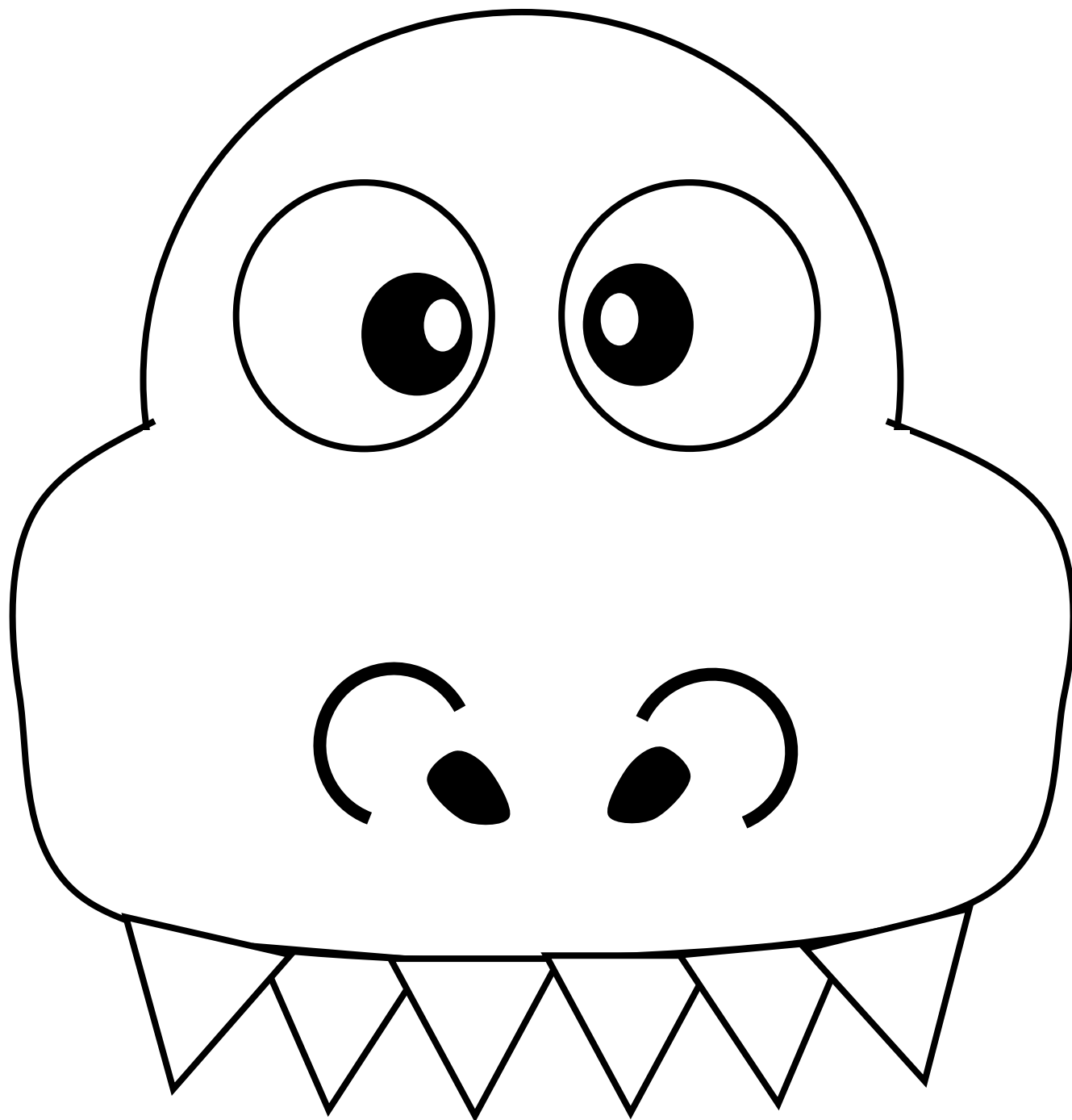
Center Band

# TYRANNOSAURUS HEADBAND

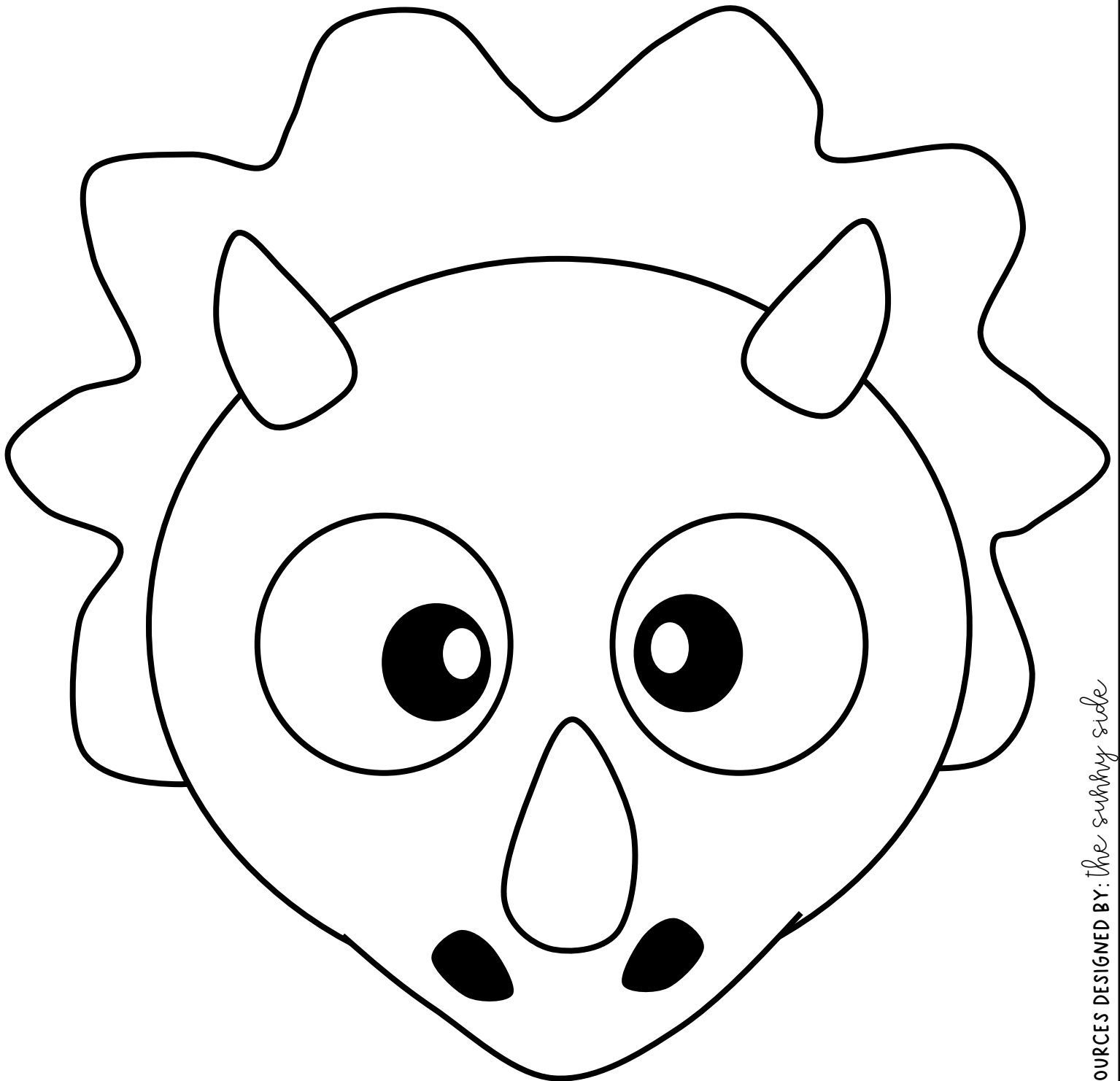
Print on white paper and decorate Tyrannosaurus face. Cut pieces apart, glue the dinosaur to headband, and staple band together to wear.
